
Hatching Chick Craft

Directions:

- 1. Color and cut out the chick craft pieces.
- 2. Cut along the jagged line on the egg to create a top and bottom half.
- 3. Overlap the top and bottom halves of the egg slightly. Poke a small hole on one side and insert a brad (fastener) to connect the pieces.
- 4. Glue the chick behind the bottom half of the egg so it peek out when you move the top half.

*** If you don't have a brad (fastener), glue the chick onto a piece of construction paper. Then, glue the bottom half of the egg over the chick's body. Glue the top half of the egg above the chick's head or next to the chick.




